ESV	These were the ones chosen from the congregation, the chiefs of their ancestral tribes, the heads of the clans of Israel.
NIV	These were the men appointed from the community, the leaders of their ancestral tribes. They were the heads of the clans of Israel.
NLT	These are the chosen leaders of the community, the leaders of their ancestral tribes, the heads of the clans of Israel."
LXX	οὗτοιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἐπίκλητοι τῆςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ greek The definite article συναγωγῆς ἄρχοντες τῶνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὁ greek The definite article φυλῶν κατὰ πατρίδας χιλῖαρχοι Ἰσραὴλ εἰσὶνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
