	יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
Hebrew	First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 את hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by מִשְׁחָה וַיִּפְקְדֵם בַּמִּדְבָּר סִינַי
ESV	as the LORD commanded Moses. So he listed them in the wilderness of Sinai.
NIV	as the LORD commanded Moses. And so he counted them in the Desert of Sinai:
NLT	just as the LORD had commanded Moses. So Moses recorded their names in the wilderness of Sinai.
