This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בְּחֲצֵרוֹת
ESV	From Kibroth-hattaavah the people journeyed to Hazeroth, and they remained at Hazeroth.
NIV	From Kibroth Hattaavah the people traveled to Hazeroth and stayed there.
NLT	From Kibroth-hattaavah the Israelites traveled to Hazeroth, where they stayed for some time.
