	הִיָּה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 כָּמֶת אִשָּׁר בְּצִאתוֹ מִרְחֹם אִמּוֹ וַיֹּאכֶל חֲצִי בִשְׂרוֹ
ESV	Let her not be as one dead, whose flesh is half eaten away when he comes out of his mother's womb.”
NIV	Do not let her be like a stillborn infant coming from its mother's womb with its flesh half eaten away.”
NLT	Don't let her be like a stillborn baby, already decayed at birth.”
