Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.</p> <p>It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1</p> |
