	יהוה־אֱלֹהֵינוּ יְהוָה־אֱלֹהֵינוּ hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 אֱלֹהֵינוּ hebrew The Hebrew אֱלֹהֵינוּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by אֱלֹהֵינוּ (אֱלֹהֵינוּ אֱלֹהֵינוּ)

ESV	If the LORD delights in us, he will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that flows with milk and honey.
NIV	If the LORD is pleased with us, he will lead us into that land, a land flowing with milk and honey, and will give it to us.
NLT	And if the LORD is pleased with us, he will bring us safely into that land and give it to us. It is a rich land flowing with milk and honey.

	The definite article γῆ
	Meaning:

	Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.
	It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 ταύτην οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
LXX	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 καὶ αὐτὴν οὗτος

	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” δῶσει αὐτὴν οὗτος
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	Meaning:

	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ῥέουσα γάλα καὶ αὐτὴν οὗτος

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μέλι
