Meaning:

* Face * Presence * Front or surface

Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. אֱלֹהֵי אֱלֹהֵי plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֱלֹהֵי

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Meanings:

* God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels

Noun, masculine רִיחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigרִיחַ

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Meaning:

* Wind * Breath * Spirit

Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament.

Though usually feminine, רִיחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). Exodus 10:13 Genesis 6:17 Genesis 41:8 Proverbs
