ESV	So Eleazar the priest took the bronze censers, which those who were burned had offered, and they were hammered out as a covering for the altar,
NIV	So Eleazar the priest collected the bronze censers brought by those who had been burned up, and he had them hammered out to overlay the altar,
NLT	So Eleazar the priest collected the 250 bronze incense burners that had been used by the men who died in the fire, and he hammered them into a thin sheet to overlay the altar.
