ESV	All those listed of the camp of Reuben, by their companies, were 151,450. They shall set out second.
NIV	All the men assigned to the camp of Reuben, according to their divisions, number 151,450. They will set out second.
NLT	So the total of all the troops on Reuben's side of the camp is 151,450. These three tribes will be second in line whenever the Israelites travel.
