	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀπὸ Βαμωθ εἰς νάπην ἢ ἔστιν εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐν
LXX	greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῷ greek The definite article πεδίῳ Μωαβ ἀπὸ κορυφῆς τοῦ greek The definite article λελαξευμένου τὸ greek The definite article βλέπον κατὰ πρόσωπον τῆς greek The definite article ἐρήμου
