Hebrew	וּבְנֵי קֹרַח לֹא מָתוּ
ESV	But the sons of Korah did not die.
NIV	The line of Korah, however, did not die out.
NLT	However, the sons of Korah did not die that day.
LXX	οἱ greek The definite article ὁ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οἱ Κορε οὐκ ἀπέθανον
KJV	Notwithstanding the children of Korah died not.

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
