| Hebrew | <div>The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.</div> <div>For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by ברא אלהים ( ראש כל עדת בני ישראל מפו עשרים שנה ומעלה לבית אבתם כל יצא צבא בישראל</div> |
