ESV	These are the clans of the sons of Ephraim as they were listed, 32,500. These are the sons of Joseph according to their clans.
NIV	These were the clans of Ephraim; those numbered were 32,500. These were the descendants of Joseph by their clans.
NLT	These were the clans of Ephraim. Their registered troops numbered 32,500. These clans of Manasseh and Ephraim were all descendants of Joseph.
