	The word אֶבֶץ can designate the whole of planet earth, or the inhabitable world or the national territory or ground.

ESV	"Take a census of the people, from twenty years old and upward," as the LORD commanded Moses. The people of Israel who came out of the land of Egypt were:
NIV	"Take a census of the men twenty years old or more, as the LORD commanded Moses." These were the Israelites who came out of Egypt:
