ESV	this is the burnt offering of every Sabbath, besides the regular burnt offering and its drink offering.
NIV	This is the burnt offering for every Sabbath, in addition to the regular burnt offering and its drink offering.
NLT	This is the burnt offering to be presented each Sabbath day, in addition to the regular burnt offering and its accompanying liquid offering.
