ESV	On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall not do any ordinary work,
NIV	On the first day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work.
NLT	The first day of the festival will be an official day for holy assembly, and no ordinary work may be done on that day.

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
