	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לָכֵם כָּל מְלֶאכֶת עֲבֹדֶה לְאׁ תַעֲשִׂוּ
ESV	And on the seventh day you shall have a holy convocation. You shall not do any ordinary work.
NIV	On the seventh day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work.
NLT	The seventh day of the festival will be another official day for holy assembly, and no ordinary work may be done on that day.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of  $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \varsigma$  depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
