Hebrew	יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 אֶת מֹשֶׁה בְּהָר־סִינַי
ESV	These are the generations of Aaron and Moses at the time when the LORD spoke with Moses on Mount Sinai.
NIV	This is the account of the family of Aaron and Moses at the time the LORD talked with Moses on Mount Sinai.
NLT	This is the family line of Aaron and Moses as it was recorded when the LORD spoke to Moses on Mount Sinai:
