ESV	To Merari belonged the clan of the Mahlites and the clan of the Mushites: these are the clans of Merari.
NIV	To Merari belonged the clans of the Mahlites and the Mushites; these were the Merarite clans.
NLT	The descendants of Merari were composed of the clans descended from Mahli and Mushi.
LXX	τῶ greek The definite article Μερᾶρι δῆμος ὁ greek The definite article Μοολι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” δῆμος ὁ greek The definite article Μουσι οὗτοι οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 εἶν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. δῆμοι Μερᾶρι
KJV	Of Merari was the family of the Mahlites, and the family of the Mushites: these are the families of Merari.
