ESV	If a man vows a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by a pledge, he shall not break his word. He shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

NLT	A man who makes a vow to the LORD or makes a pledge under oath must never break it. He must do exactly what he said he would do.
