Hebrew	* Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. NIV	“When a young woman still living in her father's house makes a vow to the LORD or obligates herself by a pledge

LXX	ἐν δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”.
