| Hebrew | <div>The word הִיְהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</div> <div>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</div> <div>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 לָכֵן נִבְּרָא צֶמַח מִן הַיָּם הַגָּדֹל תַּתְּאִי לָכֵן הָר הָהוּא</div> |

IT is most frequently translated as “and” τοῦτοplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὗτος / αὕτη /τούτο</div><div><div>greek</div><div>Meaning:</div><div>* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it</div><div>Demonstrative pronoun.</div><div>οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19</div><div>ἔσταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμι</div><div><div>greek</div><div>εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</div><div>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament.</div><div>πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
