	הָיָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big הָיָה hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 Hebrew וְהָיָה לְפָנֶיךָ הָעֵרִים לְמִקְלָט מִגֹּאֲלָה וְלֹא יָמוּת הָרֹצֵחַ עַד עֲמֻדוֹ לְפָנֶיךָ פָּנִים plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big פָּנִים hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface Noun. Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. הָעֵדָה לְמִשְׁפָּחָה
ESV	The cities shall be for you a refuge from the avenger, that the manslayer may not die until he stands before the congregation for judgment.
NIV	They will be places of refuge from the avenger, so that a person accused of murder may not die before he stands trial before the assembly.
NLT	These cities will be places of protection from a dead person's relatives who want to avenge the death. The slayer must not be put to death before being tried by the community.

IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἔσονταιplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
