ESV	“But if he struck him down with an iron object, so that he died, he is a murderer. The murderer shall be put to death.
NIV	“If a man strikes someone with an iron object so that he dies, he is a murderer; the murderer shall be put to death.
NLT	“But if someone strikes and kills another person with a piece of iron, it is murder, and the murderer must be executed.
LXX	ἐὰν δὲ

	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐν
	greek
	Preposition meaning “in”. σκεύει σιδήρου πατάξῃ αὐτόν
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

LXX	καὶ

	Meaning
	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τελευτήσῃ φονευτής ἐστιν
	greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. θανάτῳ θανατούσθω

	The definite article φονευτής
