	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (הָרֹצֵחַ בְּּפִגְעוֹ בְוֹ הְוֹא יְמִיתֶנוּ
ESV	The avenger of blood shall himself put the murderer to death; when he meets him, he shall put him to death.
NIV	The avenger of blood shall put the murderer to death; when he meets him, he shall put him to death.
NLT	The victim's nearest relative is responsible for putting the murderer to death. When they meet, the avenger must put the murderer to death.
