Hebrew	וְלֹא תִקְחוּ כֹפֶר לְנַפְשׁ רָצֹחַ אֲשֶׁר הוּא רָשָׁע לְמֹות כִּי מֹות יוֹמֵת
ESV	Moreover, you shall accept no ransom for the life of a murderer, who is guilty of death, but he shall be put to death.
NIV	“Do not accept a ransom for the life of a murderer, who deserves to die. He must surely be put to death.
NLT	Also, you must never accept a ransom payment for the life of someone judged guilty of murder and subject to execution; murderers must always be put to death.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οὐ λήμψεσθε λύτρα περὶ ψυχῆς παρὰ τοῦ greek The definite article φονεύσαντος τοῦ greek The definite article ἐνόχου ὄντος greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἀναιρεθῆναι θανάτῳ γὰρ θανατωθήσεται
