ESV	The pasturelands of the cities, which you shall give to the Levites, shall reach from the wall of the city outward a thousand cubits all around.
NIV	“The pasturelands around the towns that you give the Levites will extend out fifteen hundred feet from the town wall.
NLT	The pastureland assigned to the Levites around these towns will extend 1,500 feet from the town walls in every direction.
