ESV	According to the commandment of the LORD through Moses they were listed, each one with his task of serving or carrying. Thus they were listed by him, as the LORD commanded Moses.
NIV	At the LORD's command through Moses, each was assigned his work and told what to carry. Thus they were counted, as the LORD commanded Moses.
NLT	When their names were recorded, as the LORD had commanded through Moses, each man was assigned his task and told what to carry.And so the registration was completed, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
