Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew את־בְּרַא word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by שְׂבַעַת הַנִּרוֹת
ESV	"Speak to Aaron and say to him, When you set up the lamps, the seven lamps shall give light in front of the lampstand."
NIV	"Speak to Aaron and say to him, 'When you set up the seven lamps, they are to light the area in front of the lampstand.'"
NLT	"Give Aaron the following instructions: When you set up the seven lamps in the lampstand, place them so their light shines forward in front of the lampstand."

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
