Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) πιστεύειν ἀλλὰ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τὸ greek The definite article ὑπὲρ αὐτοῦαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) πάσχειν,
ESV	For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake,

NIV	For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for him,
NLT	For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him.
KJV	For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;
