Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) τοῦτο, plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
Greek	Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ὅτι ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἐναρξάμενος ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ὁμῖν ἔργον ἀγαθὸν ἐπιτελέσει ἄχρι ἡμέρας Χριστοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigΧριστός Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine. Ἰησοῦ.
ESV	And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.
NIV	being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
NLT	And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.
KJV	Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

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
