	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πᾶς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς
	greek
	Meaning
	* All * Every * The whole
	Adjective.
	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 γλῶσσα ἔξομολογήσεται ὅτι κύριος Ἰησοῦς Χριστός plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigΧριστός
	Christ means “anointed one”
	The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)
	Noun, masculine. εἰς δόξαν θεοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεός
	greek
	Masculine noun meaning:
	* A god or goddess * God πατρός .
	ESV and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
	NIV and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
	NLT and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
	KJV And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
