Hebrew	וְתִפְרְעוּ כָּל עֲצָתִי וְתוֹכַחְתִּי לֹא אָבִיתֶם
ESV	because you have ignored all my counsel and would have none of my reproof,
NIV	since you ignored all my advice and would not accept my rebuke,
NLT	You ignored my advice and rejected the correction I offered.
LXX	ἀλλὰ ἀκύρους ἐποιεῖτε Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship. Verb forms Present tense Person Greek Form ἐμὰς βουλὰς τοῖς greek The definite article δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐμοῖς ἐλέγχοις ἠπειθήσατε
