ESV	I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when terror strikes you,
NIV	I in turn will laugh at your disaster; I will mock when calamity overtakes you-
NLT	So I will laugh when you are in trouble! I will mock you when disaster overtakes you-
LXX	τοιγαροῦν καὶ γὰρ τῇ greek The definite article ὑμετέρᾳ ἀπωλείᾳ ἐπιγελάσομαι καταχαροῦμαι δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἡνίκα ἂν ἔρχηται ὑμῖν ὁ λεθρός
