

Proverbs 10:11

Hebrew	מִקּוֹר חַיִּים כִּי צְדִיק וּפִי רָשָׁעִים יַכְסֶּה חֶמְסָה
ESV	The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, but the mouth of the wicked conceals violence.
NIV	The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, but violence overwhelms the mouth of the wicked.
NLT	The words of the godly are a life-giving fountain; the words of the wicked conceal violent intentions.
LXX	πηγή ζωῆς ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. χειρὶ δικαίου στόμα δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀσεβοῦς καλύψει ἀπώλεια
KJV	The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.

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
