Hebrew	מִגֹּרֶת רָשָׁע הִיא תְּבוֹאָנָו וְתַאֲוֹת צַדִּיקִים יִתֵּן
ESV	What the wicked dreads will come upon him, but the desire of the righteous will be granted.
NIV	What the wicked dreads will overtake him; what the righteous desire will be granted.
NLT	The fears of the wicked will be fulfilled; the hopes of the godly will be granted.
LXX	ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀπωλεία ἀσεβῆς περιφέρεται ἐπιθυμία δὲplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δικαίου δεκτῇ
KJV	The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.

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
