Hebrew	כַּעֲבוֹר סוּפָה וְאִין רָשָׁע יִצְדִּיק יְסוּד עוֹלָם
ESV	When the tempest passes, the wicked is no more, but the righteous is established forever.
NIV	When the storm has swept by, the wicked are gone, but the righteous stand firm forever.
NLT	When the storms of life come, the wicked are whirled away, but the godly have a lasting foundation.
LXX	παραπορευομένης καταιγίδος ἀφανίζεται ἀσεβής δίκαιος δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐκκλίνας σῶζεται εἰς τὸν greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ αἰῶνα
KJV	As the whirlwind passeth, so is the wicked no more: but the righteous is an everlasting foundation.
