ESV	Like vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, so is the sluggard to those who send him.
NIV	As vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, so is a sluggard to those who send him.
NLT	Lazy people irritate their employers, like vinegar to the teeth or smoke in the eyes.
LXX	ὥσπερ ὄμφαξ ὀδοῦσι βλαβερὸν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” καπνὸς ὄμμασιν οὕτως παρανομία τοῖς greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
