ESV	The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom, but the perverse tongue will be cut off.
NIV	The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom, but a perverse tongue will be cut out.
NLT	The mouth of the godly person gives wise advice, but the tongue that deceives will be cut off.
LXX	στόμα δικαίου ἀποστάζει σοφίαν γλῶσσα δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀδίκου ἐξολεῖται
KJV	The mouth of the just bringeth forth wisdom: but the froward tongue shall be cut out.

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
