

Proverbs 10:5

Hebrew	אִגֵּר בְּקִיץ בֶּן מִשְׁכִּיל נִרְדָּם בְּקָצִיר בֶּן מְבִיט
ESV	He who gathers in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps in harvest is a son who brings shame.
NIV	He who gathers crops in summer is a wise son, but he who sleeps during harvest is a disgraceful son.
NLT	A wise youth harvests in the summer, but one who sleeps during harvest is a disgrace.
LXX	διεσώθη ἀπὸ καύματος υἱὸς νοήμων ἀνεμόφθορος δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. γίνεται ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀμήτω υἱὸς παράνομος
