Hebrew	זִכְרֹ צְדִיק לְבִרְכָּה וְשֵׁם רָשָׁעִים יִרְקָב
ESV	The memory of the righteous is a blessing, but the name of the wicked will rot.
NIV	The memory of the righteous will be a blessing, but the name of the wicked will rot.
NLT	We have happy memories of the godly, but the name of a wicked person rots away.
LXX	μνήμη δικαίων μετ' ἐγκωμίων ὄνομα δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἄσεβοῦς σβέννυται
KJV	The memory of the just is blessed: but the name of the wicked shall rot.

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
