Hebrew	רוּחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big רוח hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוח sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). ESV	Whoever goes about slandering reveals secrets, but he who is trustworthy in spirit keeps a thing covered.
NIV	A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy man keeps a secret.
NLT	A gossip goes around telling secrets, but those who are trustworthy can keep a confidence.
LXX	ἀνὴρ δίγλωσσος ἀποκαλύπτει βουλὰς ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. συνεδρίῳ πιστὸς δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πνοῇ κρύπτει πράγματα
KJV	A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.

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
