ESV	The desire of the righteous ends only in good; the expectation of the wicked in wrath.
NIV	The desire of the righteous ends only in good, but the hope of the wicked only in wrath.
NLT	The godly can look forward to a reward, while the wicked can expect only judgment.
LXX	ἐπιθυμία δικαίων πᾶσα plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big πᾶς greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 ἀγαθή ἐλπίς δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀσεβῶν ἀπολεῖται
