ESV	Whoever brings blessing will be enriched, and one who waters will himself be watered.
NIV	A generous man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed.
NLT	The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.
LXX	ψυχὴ εὐλογουμένη πᾶσα greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 ἀπλὴ ἀνὴρ δὲ greek δὲ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. θυμῶδες οὐκ εὐσχήμων
KJV	The liberal soul shall be made fat: and he that watereth shall be watered also himself.

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
