Hebrew	תִּמְתּוּ יִשְׁרִים תִּנְחָם וְסָלָף בּוֹגְדִים וְשָׁדִם יִשְׁפֹּךְ
ESV	The integrity of the upright guides them, but the crookedness of the treacherous destroys them.
NIV	The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity.
NLT	Honesty guides good people; dishonesty destroys treacherous people.
LXX	ἀποθανῶν δίκαιος ἔλιπεν μετὰμελον πρόχειρος δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. γίνεται καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπίχαρτος ἀσεβῶν ἀπώλεια
KJV	The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them.

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
