Hebrew	יֵתֵר מִרְעֵהוּ צַדִּיק וְדֶרֶךְ רָשָׁעִים תִּתְעֶם
ESV	One who is righteous is a guide to his neighbor, but the way of the wicked leads them astray.
NIV	A righteous man is cautious in friendship, but the way of the wicked leads them astray.
NLT	The godly give good advice to their friends; the wicked lead them astray.

LXX	ἐπιγνώμων δικαιος ἑαυτοῦ φίλος ἔσται greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. αἱ greek Meaning: * The The definite article.
