ESV	The wicked are overthrown and are no more, but the house of the righteous will stand.
NIV	Wicked men are overthrown and are no more, but the house of the righteous stands firm.
NLT	The wicked die and disappear, but the family of the godly stands firm.
LXX	οὗ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁς, ἦ, ὅ greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἐὰν στραφῇ ἀσεβῆς ἀφανίζεται οἶκοι δὲ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δικαίων παραμένουσιν
KJV	The wicked are overthrown, and are not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.
