

Proverbs 13:1

Hebrew	בֶּן חָכָם מְאִסֵּר אָב וְלֹץ לֹא שָׁמַע גְּעָרָה
ESV	A wise son hears his father's instruction, but a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.
NIV	A wise son heeds his father's instruction, but a mocker does not listen to rebuke.
NLT	A wise child accepts a parent's discipline; a mocker refuses to listen to correction.
LXX	υἱὸς πανοῦργος ὑπήκοος πατρί υἱὸς δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀνήκοος ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀπωλεία
KJV	A wise son heareth his father's instruction: but a scorner heareth not rebuke.

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
