ESV	Wealth gained hastily will dwindle, but whoever gathers little by little will increase it.
NIV	Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow.
NLT	Wealth from get-rich-quick schemes quickly disappears; wealth from hard work grows over time.
LXX	ὑπαρξίς ἐπισπουδαζομένη μετὰ ἀνομίας ἐλάσσων γίνεται ὁ greek The definite article ὁ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. συνάγων ἑαυτῷ μετ' εὐσεβείας πληθυνθήσεται δίκαιος οἰκτίρει καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” κιχρᾱ
KJV	Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.

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
