Hebrew	קָצַר אַפִּים יַעֲשֶׂה אֲוֵלֶת וְאִישׁ מְזֻמּוֹת יִשְׁנָא
ESV	A man of quick temper acts foolishly, and a man of evil devices is hated.
NIV	A quick-tempered man does foolish things, and a crafty man is hated.
NLT	Short-tempered people do foolish things, and schemers are hated.
LXX	ὀξύθυμος πράσσει μετὰ ἀβουλίας ἄνθρωπος δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. φρόνιμος πολλὰ ὑποφέρει
KJV	He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

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
